The Midtown community is known for its historic architecture and independent merchants. Explore this walkable district.

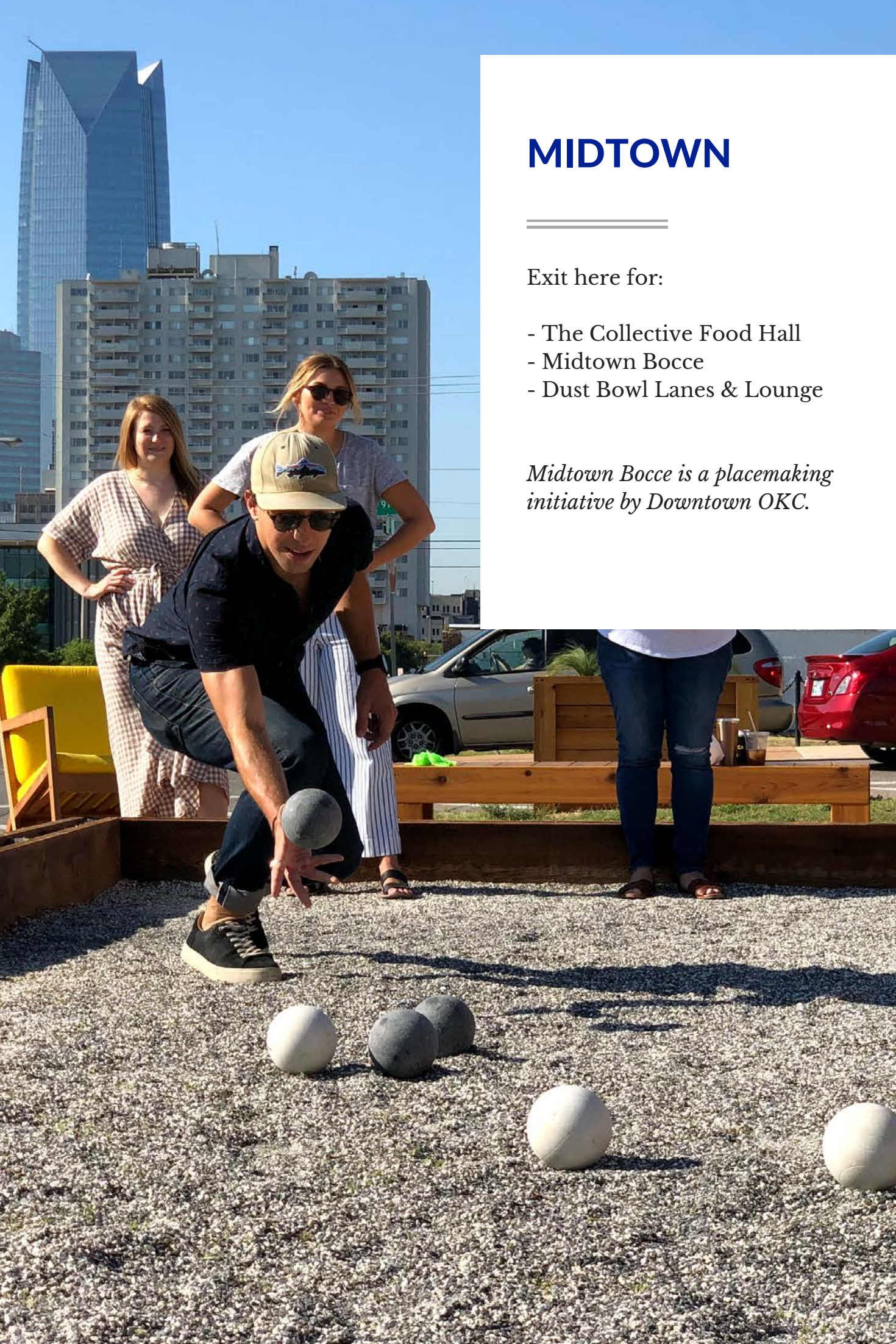


MIDTOWN
